





To deepen inclusive University education and empower the youth to transform into leaders who will make meaningful contributions to national and regional development.

- → Provide inclusive education support services and skills development to facilitate meaningful transition
- Build a strong network of transformative leaders committed to service and give back
- Influence Institutional Changes in policies and practices through engagements and learning from experiences and partnerships
- ➡ Ensure efficient and effective operational and strategic management of the Program

ELIGIBILITY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP

To be eligible for the Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program at Makerere University's main campus, the following conditions must be met:

- The applicant must qualify for admission to the Undergraduate Degree Programmes under the Private Sponsorship Scheme at Makerere University's main campus. Therefore, all applicants should apply for admission at Makerere University's main campus under the Private Sponsorship Scheme (when advertised).
- Once admitted to Makerere University's main campus, your application for the Mastercard Foundation Scholarship will be considered for the due selection process.
- The Applicant must have completed an Advanced-Level education (or its equivalent) in an African Country.
- The Mastercard Foundation Scholarships are restricted to individuals facing significant financial hardship.
- Applicants must demonstrate leadership potential and a record of community service.
- Applicants should not be holders of any other Scholarship.
- → Applicants should not have registered for or completed any other undergraduate degree Programme.
- The Applicant should not exceed 28 years of age when applying for the Scholarship.
- → Applicants under the categories of refugees and students with disabilities should not exceed 32 years of age when applying for the Scholarship.
- → A refugee applicant must be a recognized and registered refugee, and proof (refugee attestation) must be attached to the application form.

The prioritized degree programmes align the NDP III Strategic Priority Development Areas of Agriculture, Tourism, Mineral Development, and Infrastructure. (See the detailed list of courses on the application form).

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

- Only students with the minimum requirements to be admitted to Makerere University - Main Campus (https://apply.mak.ac.ug) from the categories specified in the advertisement are eligible to apply.
- ⇒ A Completed form should be submitted to only one of the following:
- i). Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program at Makerere University Offices located at Plot 144, Pool Road, Makerere University
- ii).As an attachment sent through the following email addresses: makscholarsapplication@gmail.com
- iii). Filled in online via https://apply.mcfsp.mak.ac.ug/
- Only short-listed candidates will be contacted for further selection engagements.



The Mastercard Foundation

The Mastercard Foundation is a registered Canadian charity and one of the largest foundations in the world. It works with visionary organizations to advance education and financial inclusion to enable young people in Africa and Indigenous youth in Canada to access dignified and fulfilling work. Established in 2006 through the generosity of Mastercard when it became a public company, the Foundation is an independent organization separate from the company, with offices in Toronto, Kigali, Accra, Nairobi, Kampala, Lagos, Dakar, and Addis Ababa. Its policies, operations, and program decisions are determined by the Foundation's Board of Directors and leadership.

The Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program is a global initiative designed to develop the next generation of transformative leaders by enabling highly talented, service-oriented young people, primarily young Africans, to pursue their higher education and cultivate their leadership potential. The Program is specifically targeted towards young people who face the highest economic and social barriers to opportunity. The Program places a particular emphasis on reaching young women, refugees, forcibly displaced youth, and young people living with disabilities.

The Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program at UWC

The Mastercard Foundation has partnered with the University of the Western Cape (UWC) to further contribute to the Foundation's aim of enabling 100,000 African youth to graduate from higher education institutions. Through its partnership with the Mastercard Foundation, UWC is committed to developing leaders who are transformative and will inspire and become active contributors in their communities, in so doing, making a difference in the lives of others and providing sustainable solutions towards Africa's development.

The Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program at UWC will provide full comprehensive scholarships for 250 undergraduate Mastercard Foundation Scholars (over 4 years each) and 250 master's degree Mastercard Foundation Scholars (over 2 years each) over a 7-year grant cycle. The core academic programme is complemented with a Wrap Around Support Programme (WASP) focused on health and welfare of Mastercard Foundation Scholars, support for academic success, community- engaged learning, entrepreneurial development, transition to the world of work including internships, leadership development, and alumni engagements and networks. Participation in WASP, is a compulsory component of the scholarship award.

Eligible programmes of study at UWC

- Arts & Humanities (Applied Linguistics, History, Gender Justice, Migration Studies, Sociology for Development).

- o Economic & Management Sciences (Development Studies, Information Sciences and Migration Studies).
- o Law (Governance and Human Rights).
- o Natural Sciences (Biological, Computational, Mathematical and Physical Sciences

For master's degree studies, an applicant:

- o Must be no older than 30 years at the time of application
- Provide evidence that social and economic barriers impede access to university studies.
- o Must meet the University's minimum admissions requirements and disciplinespecific requirements and have applied for academic admission to the University (for programme / discipline- specific information, visit www.uwc.ac.za).

Undergraduate degrees (Full-Time: 4-year scholarship) Applications are restricted to the following disciplines/fields of study for an undergraduate degree:

- Arts & Humanities (History, Linguistics, Sociology and Women's and Gender Studies);
- Economic & Management Sciences (Economics, Information Sciences and Public Administration);
- o Education (Mathematics and Science, Foundation Phase);
- o Natural Sciences (Biological, Computational, Mathematical and Physical Sciences).

For undergraduate degree studies, an applicant:

- o Must be no older than 26 years at the time of application
- Provide evidence that social and economic barriers impede access to university studies.
- Meet the university's minimum admissions requirements and discipline-specific requirements, and have applied for academic admission to University. (for programme / discipline-specific information, visit www.uwc.ac.za)

In addition to providing support for tuition fees, the Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program at UWC provides a range of specialised resources to facilitate Scholars' transition into dignified and fulfilling work. In particular, Scholars have access to:

- Pre-arrival support and an official on-boarding welcome programme;

- A monthly stipend and meal allowance;
